Upcoming Events

Sato presented upcoming events starting with Nengajo Contest in Nakashige sensei's absence, who will be in charge of the event. The contest format will be the same as last year unless there were any new ideas to be implemented. No new ideas were proposed by the present members and Sato moved for approval of the event the same as last year, which was approved by all attendees.

Sato presented updates on the Speech Contest with the report made by the Speech Contest Committee consisted of members from Consul-general of Japan at Houston, Japanese Association of Greater Houston, Japan-Business Association of Houston, and JTAT. Updates included:

- 1) Poem selection : will be made by Speech Contest from 2009
- 2) Regional and state contests: Houston, Dallas and San Antonio regional will be held each in February on dates provided on JTAT Website.
- 3) State Final will be on 2/23/08 at Rice University, Houston. The State final venue has changed due to its cost now charged by HISD.
- 4) State final location (2009) : Speech Contest Committee proposed change of venue because of Houston's sole operation in the event.

Sanada sensei moved to oppose the proposal for the past examples of venue in rolling cities. Sanada sensei moved to initiate the Speech Contest being centralized for Houston for the venue because of the location of CGJH which is a major reason to be conducted in Houston. Attendees seconded.
